A) Types of mass media (advantages, disadvantages)

Mass media – an important role in the society, too powerful and influential

Importance: source of information (easily available, complex, cheap)

We learn about: world around us, inventions, new technologies, achievements

- B) Press media: newspapers, magazines and journals
 - Different sorts of articles:
 - on economics, politics, social life, sports
 - Editorials (personal opinion of the editor about something in the news)
 - Features (special reports about subject, place, person)
 - > Newspapers published every day/ even at weekends
 - <u>Serious papers</u>: objective + serious news
 - <u>Tabloids</u>: entertaining stories, gossips about famous people/celebrities
 - ➤ Magazines published 1x a week/month
 - National and international news
 - various articles, stories
 - different according to: hobby/age/gender
 - ➤ Journals serious magazines written by experts

C) Radio, television

> Radio

- If we don't like reading/it's expensive to buy a newspaper every day
- We listen to the radio news read by a presenter
- Music
- Is very popular, variety of channels
- Advantage: listen throughout the day, no matter what we're doing
- Variety of radio programmes to choose from:
 - o news + weather forecast
 - o chat /quiz/ breakfast/morning shows
 - o educational programmes
 - o phone- in programmes
 - o documentaries

> Television

- The most popular source of information
- Much time spending by watching television
- Wide selection of channels and programmes more/less same as radio:
 - o News, chat/quiz shows, documentaries, educational
 - o Soap operas, sitcoms, films, cartoons

> The Internet

- the newest source of information
- Surf the various web sites to search information
- Find any type of information
- Study, relax, games, download music/films, chat, write e-mails, etc.
